



Online Tools for Distance Learning

Teachers will be using a range of online tools to communicate, share learning tasks and provide feedback to students.

So how will it work?

Each team will have a **Distance Learning** plan. Teachers will share work with students using the online tools above. Teachers will regularly check in with students and provide feedback on their work.

Teachers will meet with their classes via Zoom each day.

To support **Distance Learning**, here are some things you can do:

- Provide a quiet place to work
- Y3-6 check student emails each day
- Check new notifications on Seesaw each day
- Create a timetable/plan for each day of learning (include breaks and free time) and talk to your child about what work they have completed and what they need to work on
- Support students to complete their learning tasks - ask if they need any help
